## LOCATION

The city of Torrance sits in southwestern Los Angeles County with 1.5 miles of beaches and a moderate year-round climate. Torrance is home to one of the largest malls in the United States, the Del Amo Fashion Center. This mall serves as a main transit hub for the city and is the location of Tolar Manufacturing's highcapacity customized shelters.

## **PROJECT**

Tolar Manufacturing Company is working once again in partnership with general contractor, AP Construction, Inc. on a key Southern California transit project. The project is focused on improving amenities and accessibility along the city's RAPID route 3, including the design and fabrication of high capacity shelters at the key transit hub located at Del Amo Fashion Center.

With over 200 stores, Del Amo Fashion Center in Torrance, California attracts thousands of

visitors and draws a large employee base. The on-site transit hub is the way many travel to and from this premier lifestyle center daily. Guided by the company's Sense of Place™ philosophy, Tolar Manufacturing has designed and fabricated two, 30-foot, high-capacity transit shelters to help improve the ridership experience for these daily travelers. The shelters are modeled after the company's distinctively modern Signature Empire series, which emulates the beautiful aesthetics of the surrounding area to reflect the character of the fashion center community.

The modern shelter design with its perforated walls allows natural light and air flow to accent these elements. The transit shelters include high visibility branding, plentiful seating, lowdraw LED illuminated media display kiosks, under roof LED security lighting and real-time information signs.

In addition to the Del Amo shelters, Tolar Manufacturing has fabricated 27 smaller shelters from its Empire bus shelter line to be installed along the RAPID route. These shelters are 13-feet in length, portray highly visible route branding, and contain under roof LED security lighting.

Tolar Manufacturing, through its long-term contract with the Jacksonville Transportation Authority, worked with their team and various stakeholders to develop a menu for JTA's national recognized First Coast Flyer service.

Our portfolio of amenities includes a 15' transit shelter with advertising and non-advertising options, custom branding, Mesa benches, bike loops and a 10-ft, branded, passenger-informing totem with twin 32-in digital displays in a NEMA-rated enclosure to provide up-to-date passenger information.



## NIAGARA SERIES SMARTPLACE TRANSIT SHELTER - DALLAS, TEXAS

In February 2019, Tolar Manufacturing secured its third consecutive, multiyear contract with Dallas Area Rapid Transit. The company will be providing transit shelters and solar solutions that power self-contained LED illumination, real-time information and security devices. Additionally, Tolar Manufacturing will collaborate with DART on the design of their next generation transit shelters, which will build upon the overall Sense of Place™ being created for the DART community

Since 2008, in addition to general market shelters, Tolar Manufacturing has developed a customized SmartPlace™ transit shelter solution that includes realtime passenger information, illuminated advertising displays, night lighting, and security cameras, all powered with state-of-the-art ECM-Connect® smart solar technology provided by Urban Solar.
