
LOCATION

Located in East Central Illinois, Champaign is centrally located with Chicago to the north, Indianapolis to the east, and St. Louis to the southwest. A micro-urban city, Champaign features an extensive park system, urbandowntown, a world-class library, and a variety of work industries including health care, banking, light manufacturing, and high technology.

PROJECT

Tolar Manufacturing has designed, engineered, and manufactured nine new Signature Sunset bus shelters for the Champaign-Urbana Mass Transit District (MTD). Located on the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign campus, the shelters were specifically designed to reflect the character of the University community.

The shelters are part of the latest phase of the Multimodal Corridor Enhancement Project



To fully support the project and ensure easy implementation, the Tolar team provided on-site installation training and support for the project contractor and agency staff as the shelters were being installed, resulting in installations completed in record time. Tolar Manufacturing is on track to supply similar shelters for the next phase of MCORE Project 5 Green Street to be completed later this year.

SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA

For almost three decades Tolar Manufacturing Company has been fabricating bus shelters, street furniture, and digital advertising solutions for the city of San Diego.

Currently, Tolar Manufacturing is in a multi-year contract to design and supply transit shelters and advertising benches for the San Diego Metropolitan Transit System (MTS). Under this contract 600 shelters and 1,800+ benches are being produced over the next five years and will be installed in communities within the MTS service area.

LOS ANGELES SOUTHWEST COLLEGE TRANSIT STATION

Tolar Manufacturing adapted 16-foot shelters from its Signature Custom line to form a transit station for Los Angeles Southwest College. Working closely with the school's project architect the Tolar team created a solution that serves the transportation needs of the school's growing enrollment, while meeting site restrictions and reflecting the school's powerfully branded identity. Illuminating the bus stops with environmentally-responsible solar powered lighting was another critical element of the project.

Other environmentally-friendly features include a custom powder coat finish that emits minimal VOC's into the local environment, seating that features HDPE slats around an architectural aluminum frame.



REAL REPLICATION OF NATE RAPID

DEL AMO FASHION CENTER - TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA

Tolar Manufacturing Company completed the design and fabrication of two high-capacity transit shelters to go along with 27 smaller shelters created for Torrance's RAPID route. Guided by the company's Sense of Place™ philosophy, Tolar Manufacturing designed and fabricated the two 30-foot, high-capacity transit shelters to help improve the ridership experience for daily travelers to the Del Amo Fashion Center. The shelters are modeled after the company's distinctively modern Signature Empire series, which emulates the beautiful aesthetics of the surrounding area to reflect the character of the community.

The modern shelter design with its perforated walls allows natural light and air flow to accent these elements. The transit shelters include high visibility branding, plentiful seating, lowdraw LED illuminated media display kiosks, under roof LED security lighting and real-time information signs.
