LOCATION

The City of Santa Ana is located in Southern California about 10 miles from the California coast and approximately 50 miles south of Los Angeles. It is the second most populous city in Orange County. Founded in 1869, the city has a population of approximately 334,000 people, ranking fourth nationally among cities of over 300,000 residents, trailing only New York City, San Francisco, and Boston.

A culturally diverse city, Santa Ana has been characterized by the NY Times as, "the face of a new California, a state where Latinos have more influence in everyday life—electorally, culturally and demographically—than almost anywhere else in the country." Santa Ana is approximately four-fifths Latino.

Santa Ana boasts a beautiful walkable downtown arts and cultural scene that honors and preserves the city's heritage while building on new creative energy with galleries, theaters, boutiques and sidewalk cafes.

PROJECT SCOPE

Tolar Manufacturing has been designing and manufacturing bus shelters for Santa Ana for several years, creating unique and durable designs that reflect the character of this richly diverse community.

Tolar's latest project for Santa Ana, pictured above and top right, resulted in 12-ft Signature Sunset shelters that feature Sunset series extrusions and a radius roof with 1/8-in thick aluminum roof panels secured with gasketed pressure ribs for a watertight seal. The roof is supported by adjustable leveling shoes with spun escutcheon shoe covers, and stainless steel anchors. A perforated aluminum branding plaque with city logo discs is secured to the shelter end walls for easy identification. A revenue-generating media display kiosk, supported by UL-listed solar powered LED illumination, provides under roof security lighting. City branding continues through the steel strap bench and trash receptacle, which includes a hinged door. All amenities and shelters are protected with durable baked power coat finish.

SIGNATURE CUSTOM SANTA ANA, CA

Papel Picado themed shelters bring culture and color to Santa Ana.

Bringing the delicate intricacies of popular "papel picado" Mexican folk art to life, these 41 custom-built 14-ft to 27-ft shelters include rugged steel structures enhanced with colorful acrylic roof panels, perforated benches, and vividly colored wall elements.



SIGNATURE VOYAGER MAX LAKE GEORGE, NY

Beautifully designed to embrace the picturesque tourist town of Lake George.

A 62-ft custom axel open canopy shelter with 8-mm bronze twin-wall polycarbonate roof panels with solar illumination. Mesa platform benches with seat delineators, custom passenger information kiosk, and durable baked premium powder coat finish complete the shelter.

BRAZOS SIGNATURE AUSTIN, TX

Part of Capital Metro's Coordinated Bus Stop Street Furniture Program delivering functional street furniture of exceptional design quality.

This 12-ft shelter incorporates a radius roof, rolled posts rear wind screen, and branding banner.



SIGNATURE CRESCENT TAMPA, FL

A "Kit of Parts" approach.

These 13-ft bus shelters were created in keeping with Tolar's "Kit of Parts" approach. Available with optional end walls, agency branding, dusk-to-dawn solar powered LED illumination and a SmartLink controller allowing for remote monitoring of the solar performance. Amenities include a Mesa bench with comfortable back rest and seat delineator and 32-gallon trash receptacle.



SIGNATURE SUNSET SAN DIEGO, CA

Three decades designing and fabricating bus shelters, street furniture, and digital solutions.

17-ft advertising shelters with agency branding make a big impact on the streets of San Diego. Passengers enjoy an integrated passenger information display case, Mesa benches, pole mounted trash/recycle bin, and dusk-to-dawn solar illumination in the roof and display case.



CUSTOM VOYAGER SAN LUIS OBISPO, CA

Maximizing passenger amenities for comfort and convenience.

Four 17-ft spoke-style cantilever shelters offer flexible length adjustments to provide maximum shade. Amenities include steel strap benches, low-draw LED lighting, and back-to-back media display kiosks.

CUSTOM SIGNATURE COLUMBIA, SC

Branded shelters in various configurations with minimal unique parts to customize the transit riding experience.

This custom Signature 16-ft shelter is part of a suite of shelters for The COMET. Featuring dusk-to-dawn solar LED illumination, and branded perforated aluminum walls, these shelters were designed with easy installation in mind and a kit of amenities that vary depending on location throughout two counties.



SIGNATURE SUNSET GREENSBORO, NC

State of the art solar powers these city shelters.

This 10-ft shelter is NCDOT PEP approved with its all-aluminum construction and fully welded roof with 3/8-in clear tempered safety glass showcasing highly visible city branding. LED security lighting powered with an RMS50 solar lighting system, including 50W photovoltaic roof mounted panels, provides dusk-to-dawn illumination using UL-listed components. A 7-ft Mesa aluminum frame recycle slat bench provides seating.



SIGNATURE PACIFIC ESPANOLA, NM

Curved translucent roof and walls provide visibility beyond the shelter framing the beautiful surrounding landscape.

This brightly-colored 14-ft shelter comes with a flat advertising kiosk, perforated metal walls for airflow, opal polycarbonate curved roof panels, and a beautiful powder coat finish with easy-to-read branding.
